Mark Rothko,

(Marcus Rothkowitz)

Was born in Daugavpils on 25th September 1903 (at that time Dvinsk, Russian Empire).

In 1913 emigrated to the USA along with his family. Died in 1970 in New York.

Mark Rothko is one of the most influential artists of the 20 century's second part, the founder of abstract expressionism and color field painting. His works of art can be observed in world's most famous galleries.

DAUGAVPILS MARK ROTHKO ART CENTRE IS LOCATED in the Artillery Arsenal building (1833) of the Dinaburg Fortress. It is the place where the antiquity has recovered and goes step for step with the modernity, forming the unique and inspiring place for creativity expression.

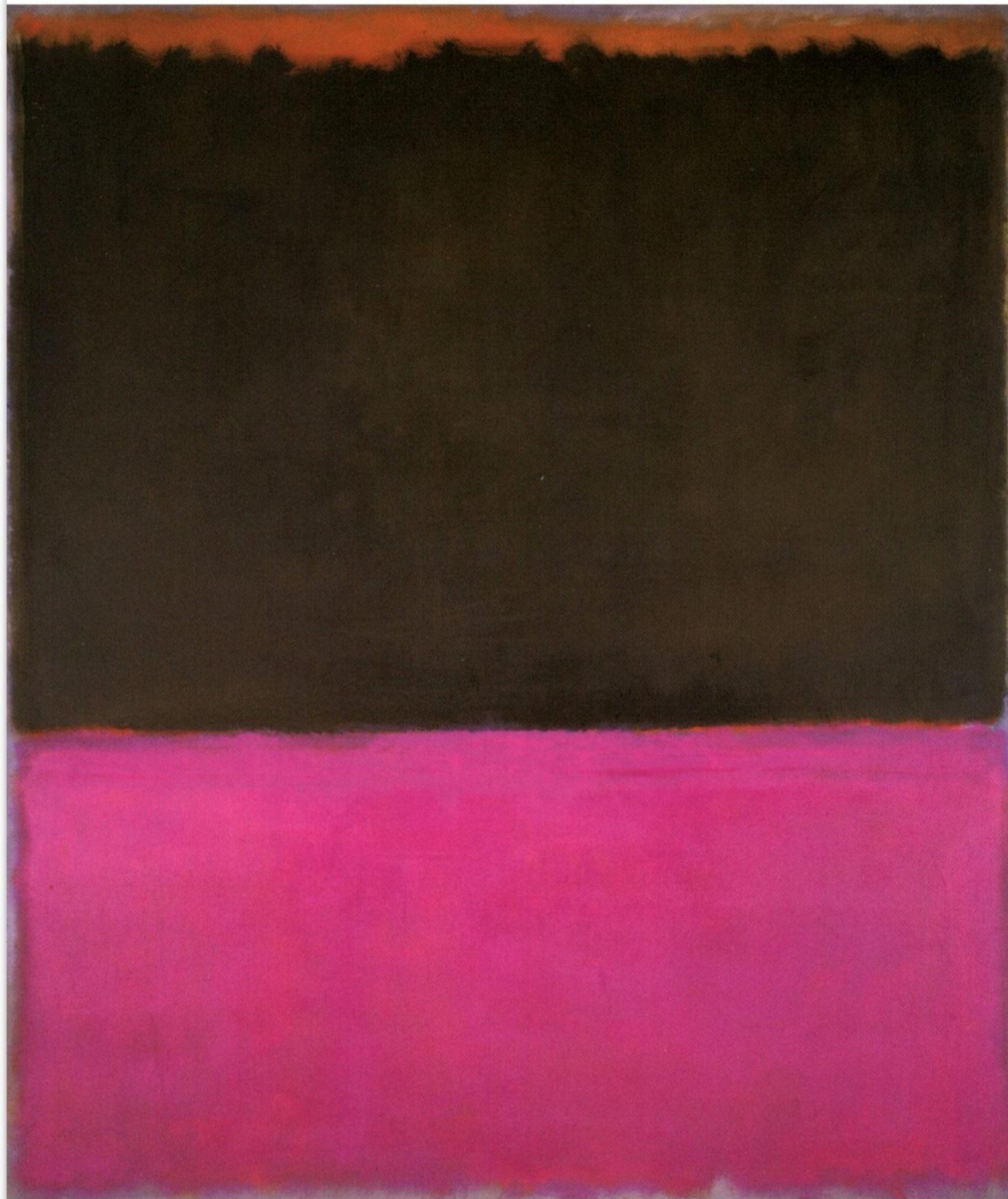

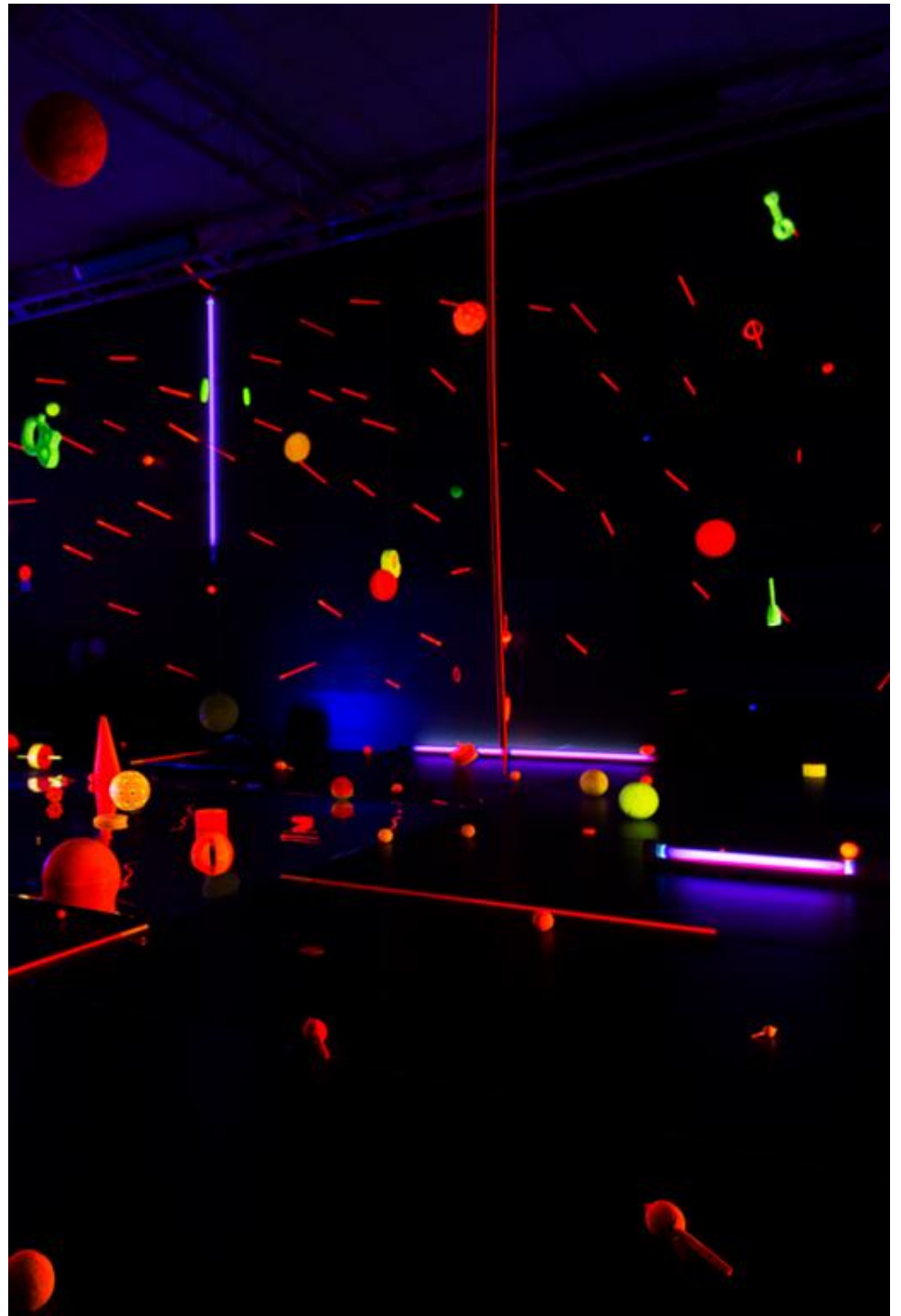

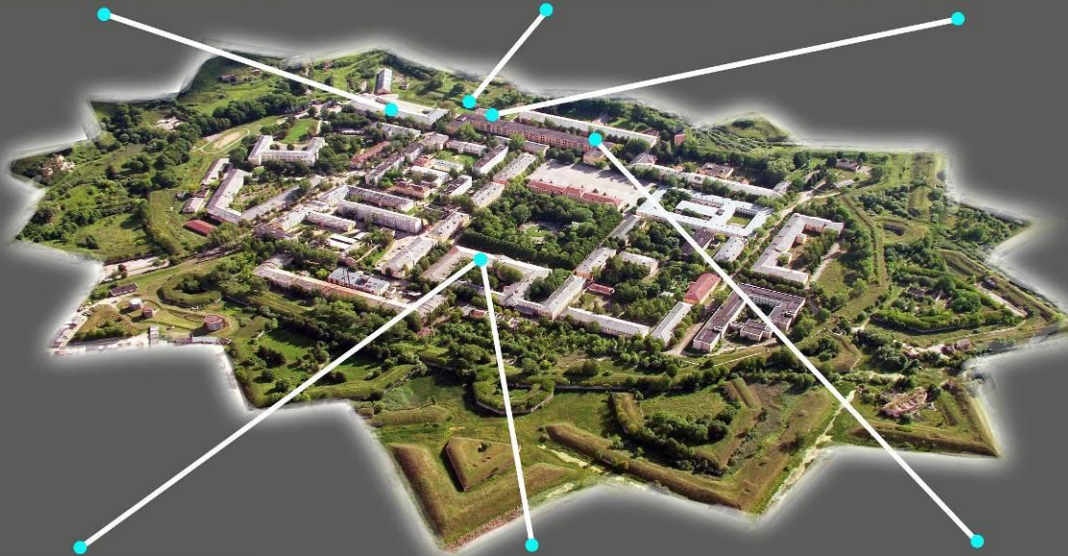
