Daugavpils and Augšdaugava municipality have a common vision, where the common values and uniqueness of the territory of each municipality, as well as common strategic goals and long-term priorities are emphasized.


VISION 2030

The State city of Daugavpils and Augšdaugava municipality - **the largest** in terms of population and the **most economically significant** State city with a functional territory in the Eastern Baltic, **unique in its diversity**, with creative, educated, and spiritually rich **people**, strong **identity** of Latgale and Sēlija and equally **attractive environment** for local people, entrepreneurs and tourists

Daugavpils – driving force for economic development in the Eastern Baltic

Augšdaugava municipality – significant functional area and strong rural space territory

Four strategic goals have been set to achieve the vision. Long-term priorities are applicable to all strategic goals, taking into account their synergy. All four priorities are equally important, they contribute to the achievement of the goals.



Medium-term strategic aims

Based on long-term aims, medium-term strategic aims have been set – medium-term priorities, courses of action and objectives. Daugavpils and Augšdaugava municipality have common medium-term priorities, common courses of action and objectives, but the actions subordinate to the objectives and investment projects are separated.

Medium-term priorities are general topical issues of territorial development, the solution of which is put in the foreground in comparison with other topical development issues, but courses of action – a set of specific measures, which are set to achieve the medium-term priorities. For this reason, medium-term priorities are defined broadly enough to ensure that the Development Program covers all areas of sustainable development that are essential to achieving long-term strategic aims.

Medium-term priority **MTP1 Active, educated, creative and healthy community** characterizes activities focused on the identity and culture of society, and on education, healthcare, social and security public services.

Medium-term priority **MTP2 Growing, recognizable and competitive business environment** characterizes the environment suitable for existing and new entrepreneurs and the support of the municipality in creating such an environment, strengthening cooperation, developed employment, various innovations and tourism development.

Medium-term priority **MTP3 Sustainable housing, environment and infrastructure** characterize the work of the municipality in facilitating the availability of housing, mitigating climate change, managing public open space and territory, and preserving cultural and historical heritage.

Medium-term priority **MTP4 Environmentally friendly and integrated mobility** characterizes the development of a sustainable mobility system, both from the point of view of integrated infrastructure and environmentally friendly modes of transport.

Medium-term priority **MTP5 Strong, independent sectoral management and synergy** characterizes the development of services provided by the municipality, the improvement of management and communication in the newly formed Augšdaugava municipality, which consists of 27 administrative units, and in the city of Daugavpils, as well as the development of mutual cooperation.

In addition to the thematic priorities, **horizontal priorities** are set, which are applicable to all courses of action, given that they intertwine and affect all areas of development: equal opportunities policy, balanced territorial development, cooperation, communication, sustainability, innovation, smart solutions, environmental accessibility, climate neutrality, adaptability, climate resilience, mitigation of Covid-19 consequences, protection of nature and biodiversity, cultural and historical heritage. For example, environmental accessibility is important both in education, sport and other areas.

The courses of action are a set of specific measures and are formulated as areas, emphasizing that all defined courses are focused on the development and improvement of the areas. The courses of action and the objectives subordinate to them concern **all areas and functions under the responsibility of the municipality** – education, sports, social protection, healthcare, management, services, security, city recognition, tourism, culture, support for entrepreneurship, mobility, housing, public open space, urban infrastructure, environment, etc. It promotes the development of society, the quality of life and work environment, business environment, development of the region. The interaction of these factors and consequences has a significant impact on the three elements on which sustainable development is based: the society, the economy and the environment.

In total, 25 courses for action to achieve the strategic aims and the resulting **91 objectives** are set out in the Development Program – a set of initiatives that is clearly defined, measurable and verifiable. The numbering of courses of action and objectives does not give any priority – all courses of action are equally important for the balanced and sustainable development of the region.
